## Prequalification of Vendors for Supply of Goods & Services

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Tuesday April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at Close of Business (5:30PM EAT)

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN) is a Swiss-based foundation launched at the UN in 2002 to tackle the human suffering caused by malnutrition, working with both governments and private businesses, we aim to transform food systems so that they deliver more nutrition's food for all people, especially the most vulnerable.

GAIN has contributed to fighting malnutrition in Ethiopia through innovative and sustainable models that increase access to affordable nutritious foods among communities vulnerable to malnutrition, since being mandated to do so in 2012. GAIN Ethiopia was registered and accorded legal personality with registry Number 2896 by the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia Authority for Civil Society Organization and continues to collaborate with the Government of Ethiopia and other stakeholders working on improving nutrition - from civil society, businesses and development partners - to build sustainable food systems for a more equal society.

#### 2. PRE-QUALIFICATION NOTICE

GAIN Ethiopia Country Office is in the process of registering vendors for supplies of Good and Services for the next two years. Interested and eligible suppliers are invited to apply, and the invitation is applicable to both existing and prospective vendors. It is important to note that the pre-qualification process does not guarantee a company or an individual for the supply of services or goods.

## 3. PRE-QUALIFICATION - EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The main objective of the prequalification is to maintain a register of vendors under relevant tenders/quotations to GAIN Ethiopia as and when required for the next two years.

Suppliers and consultants registered with the Registrar of Companies under the Laws of Ethiopia for specific merchandise or services in categories as indicated in a schedule below are invited to submit their pre-qualification documents to the GAIN Ethiopia Office. This pre-qualification is necessary for the subsequent submission of quotations and

- proposals. Prospective vendors (suppliers, service providers and consultants) must provide mandatory information for the pre-qualification process.
- All required documents and Completed pre-qualification documents should be submitted via electronic mail ONLY at <a href="mailto:ethiopiaoffice@gainhealth.org">ethiopiaoffice@gainhealth.org</a> HARD COPY DOCUMENTS SHALL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- Submissions must be received on or before **Tuesday**, **April 15**<sup>th</sup>, **2025**, at **17:30 EAT**. - Applicants are encouraged to submit applications at least one day ahead of the deadline for submission, in order to avoid any technical/unforeseen obstacles during the submission.

## 5. PRE-QUALIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### **Pre-qualification Document**

➤ Prospective vendors must submit all the requested information to be considered for pre-qualification by completing the questioner <a href="https://forms.office.com/e/1Vyv4rEZXw">https://forms.office.com/e/1Vyv4rEZXw</a> and attaching in PDF format all required document via email to <a href="mailto:ethiopiaoffice@gainhealth.org">ethiopiaoffice@gainhealth.org</a>

- Failure to provide any required mandatory documents will result in automatic disqualification. All information shared will be handled confidentially by GAIN Ethiopia. We have implemented appropriate security measures to prevent accidental loss, unauthorized access, use, alteration, or disclosure of any data or information shared. Access to the data or information transmitted will be limited by GAIN Ethiopia to employees, partners and other third parties with a legitimate business need to know. GAIN Ethiopia will retain any data or information shared as long as necessary to fulfill its collected purpose.
- ONLY soft copy prequalification application and all other requested information and documents shall be submitted via electronic mail to <a href="mailto:ethiopiaoffice@gainhealth.org">ethiopiaoffice@gainhealth.org</a> to be received by GAIN Ethiopia
- ➤ GAIN Ethiopia retains the right to request additional information from prospective vendors without providing a specific explanation for such requests. Requests for quotations will be extended solely to those suppliers and service providers who have successfully passed the pre-qualification stage and have been formally notified in writing as successful pre-qualified entities for GAIN Ethiopia during the period specified in this pre-qualification document. Success in pre-qualification is determined by scoring more than 60 points upon completion of the pre-qualification process.

## 6. PRE-QUALIFICATION DATA FORMS

#### Qualification

It is acknowledged and agreed that the pre-qualification data on prospective suppliers and service providers will be utilized by the GAIN Ethiopia Office to assess at its sole judgment and discretion, the qualifications of potential suppliers and service providers concerning the prequalification category as outlined by the client.

#### Withdrawal of prequalification

If a situation occurs between the time the company is pre-qualified to any service or good and the date of participating in a bid or quotation that could significantly affect the bidder's performance and qualifications or their capability to perform, including but not limited to bankruptcy, ownership changes, or new obligations, GAIN Ethiopia shall reserve the right to disqualify such a supplier from further pre-qualification or even reject the tender from such a supplier, even if they have been initially pre-qualified.

#### 7. ESSENTIAL CRITERIA FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION

#### Mandatory Requirements

Failure of potential vendors to provide the following mandatory requirements shall be disqualified. i.e. Unfulfilling these criteria is the primary factors that determine whether or not a company or an individual can proceed with the next pregualification process.

#### For Firms (organizations)

- A. To Complete the 'GAIN Ethiopia Country Office Vendors (Supplier and/or Service Providers) Registration Forms'
- B. To share scanned copies of documents listed below:
  - 1. Renewed Trade/Business License
  - 2. Commercial Registration Certificate
  - 3. TIN Certificate
  - 4. VAT Registration Certificate (if any)
- C. Company Profile

#### For Individuals Service Providers / Consultants

- 1. Well organized CV / Individual Profile
- 2. A summary of past experience along with some explanation on the nature and achievement of each service provided
- Educational and training accomplishment credentials which verify individual's skills, knowledge, and qualifications

## 8. PREQUALIFICATION CRITERIA AND SCORING SYSTEMS

Prospective vendors are required to submit all the information requested. Suppliers who do not meet any of the mandatory requirements as specified on the **Essential Criteria for Pre-Qualification** section above shall be automatically disqualified. Applications that meet the mandatory requirements and eligible to be registered in GAIN Ethiopia vendors data base system shall be evaluated by GAIN Ethiopia on the basis of compliance with the eligibility, completeness and quality of information provided, references, experience, evidence of ability to perform, and the overall financial soundness of the vendor.

GAIN Ethiopia shall include the following sections in the evaluation criteria and individual rates to achieve a total score of 100 percent.

#### 9. IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE CONSIDERED

- Each condition will result in the assessment of a company as either:
  - a. Acceptable standard 60 percent and above.
  - b. Not meeting requirements Below 60 percent of the total marks.
- Only suppliers whose applications are shortlisted by GAIN Ethiopia after the completion of the pre–qualification process shall be able to receive and respond to request for quotations.
- The GAIN Ethiopia Office holds absolute discretion in determining a company's score, with minimum marks required in each category. GAIN Ethiopia Office will notify the selected bidders of the outcome in writing.
- Any effort by a supplier to influence GAIN Ethiopia Office in the evaluation of applications or decisions related to this exercise shall result in the rejection of the vendor's application.
- GAIN Ethiopia Office shall reserve the right to carry out further due diligence on any category of potential applicants through a source audit exercise for accepted vendors.

#### 10. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Carefully read the instructions before completing the questionnaire. Note that submission of false information will lead to automatic disqualification.
- 2. Responses to the prequalification questionnaire must be in accordance with the requirements for information in the documents.
- Submission of pre-qualification documents: The Application Form should be completed online and all relevant supporting documents including company profile should be submitted directly via email.
- 4. The relevant supporting documents and company profile to be shared via email should be supported by a cover letter signed by the authorized representative of the organization and needs to be stamped
- Applications may be modified or withdrawn in writing, prior to the closing time specified in this Document. Applications shall not be modified or withdrawn after the deadline.
- The applicant shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the Application and GAIN will not in any case be responsible and liable for the costs incurred.
- 7. All information given in writing to or verbally shared with the contractor in connection with this pre-qualification is to be treated as strictly confidential. The contractor shall not share or invoke such information to any third party without the prior written approval of GAIN. This obligation shall continue after the procurement process has been completed whether or not the contractor is successful.
